<b>REGULATION OF THE ELECTION SYSTEM</b>	<i>Dayton Agreement</i>	
	<i>BiH Election Law 2001 amended on several occasions, the last one in 2006</i>	
<b>ACTIVE VOTE (ELECTOR)</b>	<i>Age</i>	+ 18 years old
	<i>Electoral Census</i>	On must be inside the census
	<i>Sex</i>	Both
<b>PASIVE VOTE (CANDIDATE)</b>	<i>Age</i>	+ 18 years old
	<i>Cannot be candidate</i>	- Declaration by a final judicial decision as incapable of action because of mental incapacity.
	<i>Incompatibilities</i>	-Serving a sentence imposed by the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia. - Occupying positions of judges of regular and Constitutional, prosecutor...
	<i>Requirements</i>	-
<b>TYPE OF CANDIDATURES</b>		Political Parties Coalitions Independents candidates
<b>FORM OF CANDIDATURE</b>		All of them are blocked lists. Saint Lagüe
<b>NUMBER OF ELECTORAL DISTRICTS</b>		FBiH. 5 multi- member constituencies choose 21 members. RS: 3 multi- member constituencies choose 9 members.
<b>TYPE OF ELECTORAL DISTRICTS</b>		Variable, moda – 9 (most frequent value)
<b>ELECTORAL TRESHOLD</b>		3 % : parties
<b>LENGTH OF ELECTION MANDATE</b>		4 years
<b>NUMBER OF SEATS IN ASSEMBLY</b>		42
<b>ORGAN IN CHARGE OF SUPERVISING THE ELECTION PROCESS</b>		CEC (Central Electoral Comision)
